



# The Rules

1. Absolutely **no** cell phones can be used. If you are caught using a cell phone, you will be disqualified.
2. No transportation outside of your own two legs may be used (bikes, motorcycles, mopeds, bus, car, wheelie shoes, skateboards, etc)-unless provided in a challenge. Use of these will get you disqualified.
3. Each team must have one person over the age of 18 to participate, under 18 must have parental permission signed and turned in prior to the race.
4. There's no telling what kind of activity you or your team will need to complete, so dress accordingly. We suggest checking out the weather conditions (tennis shoes, sweatshirts, bathing suits, etc)
5. Teams must have a similar color shirt/hat/button/theme, etc so that judges can tell what members belong together
6. Members must remain within 20 feet of each other at all times, unless completing a task that requires you to separate. This is to ensure that a "team" makes it to each station, not parts of the team, in order to continue on. Challenges cannot be started until all members of a team are present.
7. You may not get help from anyone outside of your team (pedestrians, other teams, etc) to complete tasks, but you may use them to help with finding your destinations (asking questions/directions, etc).
8. All challenges must be completed as stated in the clue/instructions or your team will be asked to redo the challenge (by a judge) or be disqualified.
9. Should a tie occur, we will defer to the "line judges" for the final decision after making sure all items are collected and challenges completed as required.
10. The winner is the first team to cross the finish line after completing all tasks and/or getting all of the necessary items.
11. You will not need any money during the challenges, but you will be disqualified if you attempt to use it to gain an advantage in the race. (paying for a clue, etc)
12. You must obey all regular traffic rules/signs while navigating downtown.
13. BBBSCVA has no input in the splitting of the prizes between members of the teams.
14. We are all out to have a good time, so anyone not exemplifying good sportsmanship (inappropriate behavior/language) can be disqualified.
15. You will be entering businesses during their normal operating hours. Be respectful to the business and its customers.
